

Solutions to Your Problem of Getting Appointment Before Prescription Runs Out

You might consider some of the following ways to work on the problem you identified of having trouble getting an appointment with your child's doctor before the prescription runs out.

Explain office process for refills

Ask your child's doctor about the office process for refills. Perhaps there is an easier or quicker way to get refills. Your doctor might not even require an appointment to give you a refill.

Find doctor with more open appointment times

You might be able to find a doctor who has better appointment times for your schedule. You can contact your insurance company to get a list. Or maybe your doctor would even have a suggestion. Or perhaps you have a friend or family member who knows of one.

Schedule next appointment at last visit

Before you leave your doctor's office, schedule your child's next appointment. This way you won't have to worry about remembering to schedule an appointment before the prescriptions runs out. And you are more likely to get an appointment time that works with your schedule.

Set Reminder to Schedule Appointment

Set a reminder in your calendar to schedule the next appointment before your child's prescription runs out.
