

Solutions to Problem of Not Giving Permission to School/Daycare to Give Medicine

You might consider some of the following ways to work on the problem you identified of not giving permission to school/daycare to give medicine.

Ask child to get form from nurse

If you have a child who is school aged, perhaps you can give your child a note that will allow him/her to get a permission form from the nurse for administering medicine.

Call school/daycare

Perhaps you can call the school or daycare and ask to arrange a time to sign a permission form.

Ask for form at school/daycare at dropoff/pickup

Perhaps you can ask the school or day care for a permission form to fill out when you drop or pick up your child.

Schedule reminder to ask for form

If you are having trouble remembering to get a permission form, perhaps you can set yourself a reminder in your phone.

Give permission letter/form from your doctor

Perhaps you can get a standard permission letter or form from your doctor to give to the school or daycare.
