Requesting an Initial Evaluation

Under the IDEA, you have the right to ask the school to evaluate your child. It's best to make this request in writing, in a formal letter, that you may send by email or through the postal service. If your child has been identified by your doctor or other professionals as having a disability, you will want to include this information in your letter to the school. You may also want to provide copies of any reports you have received that describe your child's condition. If you decide to write the school and ask that your child be evaluated, here's a brief example of what you may want to say.

Sample Letter: Requesting an Initial Evaluation

I understand that a determination must be made about the information needed and assessment tools to be used for my child's evaluation and that I must give written permission in order for him/her to be evaluated. I look forward to discussing this matter with you and the appropriate school staff at the earliest opportunity so that (child's name) can be promptly evaluated.
